- (1) Crews should be on the water at least 20 minutes before the start times of their division.
- (2) **Time Penalties**
 - (a) Crews must be clear of the jetty at least **15 minutes** before the start of their division
 - (b) Crews must be downstream of the QE Bridge at least **10 minutes** before the start of their division. Any crew breaching either of these rules will be awarded a 15 second time penalty at the end of the race. Two penalties will apply if both rules are broken. The launching area is likely to be busy and it is your responsibility to allow for this.
- (3) Medals will be awarded in all events which attract more than one entrant. No crew will be awarded more than one prize in any one division.
- (4) The Races will be rowed over a 3000 metre upstream course from Victoria Bridge to Ruthrieston and will be rowed according to the rules of Scottish Rowing (SR).
- (5) Entry Fees (which include the Scottish Rowing levy) are as follows.

FOURS HOR on Saturday £5 per head for all fours (except *Time Only* @ £6/head)
SMALL BOATS HOR on Sunday £5 per head for all competitors
- (6) Entries for both events close on **Wednesday 12th November at 11pm** and should be made by email using the forms (Excel) downloadable from the Committee of the Dee website (<https://cofd.co.uk>) and emailed back to entries@cofd.co.uk

- (7) The starting order will be drawn up according to last year's results. New entrants will be added at the end of each event.
- (8) We welcome selected boats to enter the *Time-Only (TO)* events on Saturday and be timed over the course. **We will only accept Fours or Quads** in this event and the **entry fee for this is £30**. The starting order will be decided upon by the organising committee. This is an official event and competitors will be subject to all normal SR rules of racing. Prizes will not be offered in this event. The committee reserve the right to refuse to accept entries if we feel they would compromise the safety or organisation of the event.
If possible, (*TO*) entries will be moved to appropriate other events.
Times will not be published in the event of a disqualification.
- (9) Rules and a map of the course can be downloaded from our website. The starting order will be published there after the draw. Please check here for any weather/ parking updates prior to the event. Results will also be published there when available.
- (10) Mixed events must have at least 50% female competitors (can be more).
