Aberdeen Sprint Regatta – Notes

- All races will be rowed in accordance with Scottish Rowing rules including those relating to boat construction (heel restraints, buoyancy etc).
- Entry fees include the Scottish Rowing levy.
- Mixed events must have at least 50% of rowers female (but can be more).
- If only one entry is received for an event then the crew will, where possible, automatically be placed in the next higher status event unless otherwise stated at time of entry.
- Individuals can enter a maximum of three events.
- Masters events will be handicapped according to standard tables. Please make sure you state the Masters category of your crew at time of entry.

Entries must be made using the Excel spreadsheet which can be downloaded from our website. [**https://cofd.co.uk**](https://cofd.co.uk) It is essential that all SR (or equivalent) licence numbers are included as these are used to detect doubling-up and allocate appropriate race times.
